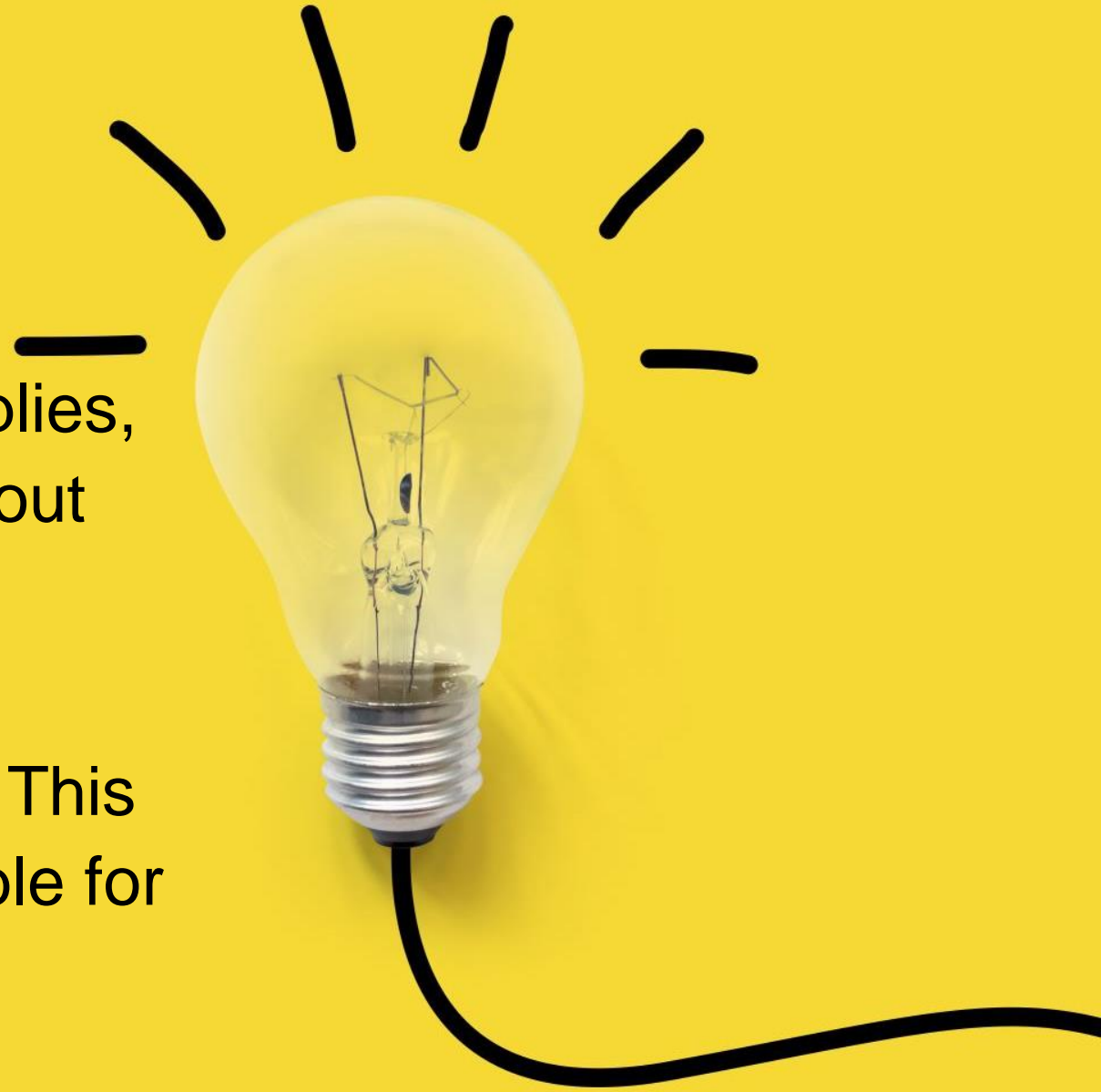

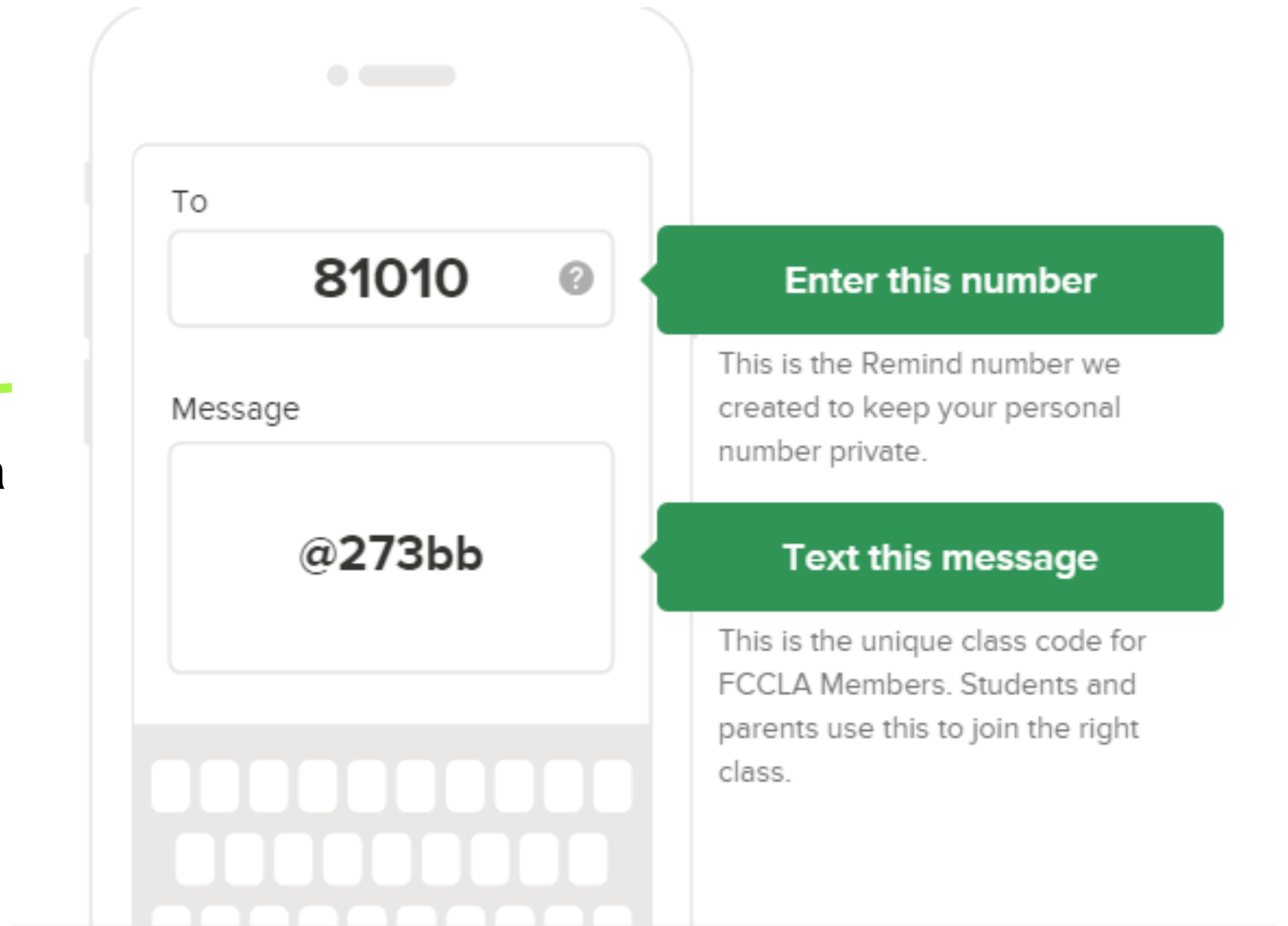
- Levels

- Events start and end at different levels.
- Some events can be done with a partner.
- You must be devoted and have the time. Most events will require you to come work on your project once a week starting in Sept. However, some events will require you to come more than once a week.
- Officers are required to compete.
- Any medals won while a member can be worn on your graduation gown your senior year.
