- Please have your parents sign the permission slip found in the packet. This informs them that you are responsible for the cash and/or items being sold.



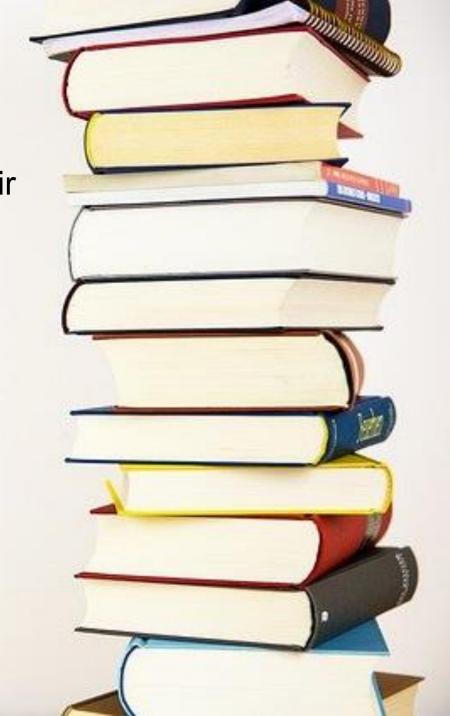


Graduation
